

GENERAL RULES OF GOLD WINDS SAILING ACADEMY

To ensure a safe, respectful, and productive environment during all training and sailing activities organized by Gold Winds Sailing Academy, the following rules must be observed by all participants:

1. Personal equipment:

The academy is not responsible for the loss, damage, or breakage of any personal items or sailing gear brought by the participants.

2. Damage to facilities:

Participants will be held responsible for any damage they may cause to the facilities of the yacht club, accommodation, or any associated premises. Gold Winds Sailing Academy reserves the right to request compensation for such damages.

3. Behavior and discipline:

Participants are expected to maintain respectful and responsible behavior at all times. The following behaviors are strictly prohibited:

• Leaving the accommodation without prior authorization from the assigned supervisor.

• Disregarding the schedules and routines set by the academy.

• Bullying, disrespectful behavior, or aggression towards fellow sailors, staff, or coaches.

• Failing to communicate any issues that may affect the participant's physical, emotional, or logistical well-being.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in disciplinary actions. In serious cases, this could include immediate expulsion from the clinic, with prior notification to the participant's family or legal guardians.

4. Medical conditions and allergies:

Any relevant medical condition (such as allergies, chronic illnesses, or ongoing treatments) must be reported to the academy in advance so that appropriate precautions can be taken.

5. Valid Sailing Federation License:

All sailors must hold a valid national sailing federation license for the year in which the training or event takes place.

6. Image rights:

All participants must complete and sign the Image Rights Authorization Form in order to participate in any events organized by the academy.
